Outlook - Mozambique

- Concurrent shocks: climate change, COVID-19, conflict, effects of Ukraine war
- Poverty and inequalities increasing
- Expectations for growth (LNG) 2022 3.8%, 2023 8.3%, 2025-2026 13.8.% – depends on security situation
- Dependence on development funding continues (IMF, WB, AfDB, UN, EU+MSs)



Mozambique – TEIs

- E-youth and Green Deal
- Advocacy and policy dialogue tool
- EU and Member states development funding under two ”umbrellas”
- Development financing programming continues as it is – each country/agency and EU continues with their programmes and procedures, including procurement
- Joint intervention logic being prepared, not approved yet
- Monitoring and steering/dialogue structures to be agreed upon
- E-youth 11 member states EU participate/contribute
- Finland (Embassy) in the task force for E-youth
