

EU's development policy and funding - changes for 2021-2027




- Focus in deepening cooperation with Africa
 - New international competition, migration, huge needs
- Need for consolidation of EU activities (multiple instruments and overlapping activities)
 - Team Europe Initiatives
 - Single funding instrument <u>NDICI</u> (or Global Europe)
- Traditional development assistance is not enough
 - Leveraging private funding (blending, guarantees)
 - Global Gateway strategy to mobilize 300 billion € for investments

NDICI = Neighborhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument, supports partner countries



Finland's involvement in Sub-Saharan Africa



- Country Team Europe Initiatives
 - Finland participates in designing of 6 TEIs, following the rest
- Regional Team Europe Initiatives (and flagship programmes)
 - Digital4Development (D4D) Hub: Data Governance in Sub-Saharan Africa; African European Digital Innovation Bridge; Digital & Green Transition
 - ASEAN, Central Asia, and LAC under consideration
 - Education and TVET initiatives: Opportunity-driven Skills and VET in Africa; Regional Teachers Initiative in Sub-Saharan Africa
- EU-supported private sector investments
 - FINNFUND

Global Gateway





- Global Gateway is EU's new *geopolitical* strategy guiding the investments globally and especially in partner countries
- Global Gateway will aim at mobilizing investments of up to **€300 billion** between 2021 and 2027 in *climate, energy, transport and digital* infrastructure, health or education systems
- EU Financing: guarantees and blending (EFSD+)
- European development finance institutions (EDFI) and European Investment Bank (EIB) were able to apply for the investment guarantees from European Commission


